•*Attention THE WINDSCREEN installation is mounted with the arm to the right (Fig. 14)

- •*Insert the rubber seal on the half-shell (fig. 01)
- •*Insert the other rubber seal on the handlebar stem (Fig. 02)
- •*Insert the half shells on the handlebar stem (Fig. 03)
- •*put the screws on the inside of the holes, by inserting in the part opposite the nuts (fig. 04)
- •*Screw with Allen Key #5 (not supplied), but not totally secure)in cross direction (fig.05)
- •*slightly tilt, until the desired position (Fig. 06)
- •*take the port block screen and insert the bolt (Fig. 07)
- •*introduce the port block screen on the attachment to handlebar (Fig. 08)
- •*Insert nut (fig.09), make sure that the latch of the display port is at the end of the stroke and does not rotate (Fig. 10)
- •*Screw with the appropriate wrench #5 (not supplied), until the display port is fixed and will not move
- •*Insert the screen into the slit , up to block; •*To remove the screen , raise the lever lock screen and slip it off:
